Guru Nanak Dev Ji

- Guru Nanak Dev Ji was born on 15 April 1469 at Rai Bhoi di Talvandi (It is now known as Nankana Sahib near Lahore, Punjab, Pakistan).
- His father was Mehta Kalyan Chand Das Bedi popularly known as Mehta Kalu Ji, and Mother Mata Tripta Ji.
- His father was a Patwari (a revenue Officer) of Talwandi.

Bebe Nanki Ji (Sister)

- Bebe Nanki Ji was the elder sister of Guru Nanak Dev.
- Bebe Nanaki was married to Bhai Jai Ram Ji, a reputed Revenue official of Sultanpur Lodhi. Sultanpur was then the capital of the Jalandhar Doab.
- At her insistence, Nanak Dev Ji at the age of 18 years followed her to live with her and her husband at Sultanpur.
- Bhai Jai Ram ji got Guru Nanak Dev Ji employed in the service of Daulat Khan Lodhi the Nawab of Sultanpur.

Family of Sri Guru Nanak Dev Ji

- On 24 September 1487 Guru Nanak Dev Ji married Mata Sulakkhani, daughter of Mul Chand and Chando Rani, in the town of Batala.
- 2. They had two sons, Sri Chand ji and Lakhmi Chand Ji.
- Sri Chand received enlightenment from Guru Nanak's teachings and went on to become the founder of the Udasi sect.


Early Life of Guru Nanak


Early in Life Guru Nanak showed sign of Knowledge and Intelligence beyond his age. To each of his preceptors, he displayed extraordinary sagacity not only in mastering their instructions but in questions which he asked them.

- At the age of 6 he learned Hindi and Sanskrit from Pandit Brijlal.
- At the age of 13, He learned Persian and Arabic from Maulvi Qutab-ud-Din.


From early age Nanak thought only of Creator and expressed remarkable role of the Divine powers.

Nanak was pained to see deep divide in the society on caste lines and atrocities inflicted on common man by the Rulers and discrimination by High Caste Priests.






Guru Nanak discarded religious rituals which created difference among people of society.



- Janeou is considered a sacred thread worn by upper caste Hindu's.
- Guru Nanak as a child of 11 years refused to wear sacred thread called Janeou. He stated that instead he would wear the true name of God in his heart for his blessings.
- He reasoned with Pandit
 Hardyal "Pandit Ji if you have a
 Janeou for soul than put it, This
 will not break or soiled, it will
 neither burn nor perish".




Once his father gave him Rs 20 for business, While he was going to market, He saw a group of hungry and weak Saints.


@ Sultanpur Lodhi (Near Jalandhar)

- While at Sultanpur, Nanak had a mystic experience. He was then thirty
 years. One day he did not return after bath from bank of a stream. Those
 who went to look for him found his clothes. It was feared that he has
 drowned.
- The Nawab and the fellow countrymen were distraught. Only Nanki (Sister) was unperturbed as she was convinced of his return.
- It is believed that during his absence Nanak had communication with the Creator, where he was told to return and spread the name of one God.
- Nanak reappeared after three days, He did not respond to any questions on his absence. The following day he gave a strong message to the society:

"There is neither a Hindu, there is no Mussalman"

(all are creation of one God and all are his children)

Last days of Guru Nanak

- He selected Bhai Lehna Ji as successor who had remained with Guru
 Nanak for 7 years as a loyal and an obedient devout disciple to carry on
 the torch of Sikhism.
- He embraced him and called him Angad (My own limb) and bestowed Guruship on 02 Sept 1539 by bowing before him, handing over Gurbani and Bhagat Bani collected by him during Udasian and left for heavenly abode.
- The light of Guru Nanak Ji merged into Guru Angad Den ji (Bhai Lehna).
- Guru Angad Ji was followed by another eight Gurus till the last 10th Guru
 Guru Gobinf Singh ji installed Sri Guru Granth Sahib as present Guru in
 1706.
