


Baba Ajit Singh in Chamkaur Sahib




Baba Ajit Singh's Vow

Guru Ji blessed Baba Ajit Singh Ji through His graceful vision from the mud fort of Chamkaur Sahib,


Guru Ji said, "Well done my son, you've fought very fearlessly."

- He later saw Anwar Khan who was commanding his army. Baba Ji went towards him and struck him with his Katar (dagger), by then he was surrounded.

Baba Ajít Síngh Jí was then struck with arrow, bullets and spears. His body was pierced by over 320 arrows and many bullets before he blew His last breath. He was only 18 years old.
